Water-dilutable sanitary cleaner

Environmental impacts of the product are predominantly due to its acidity and its content of surfactants, which are toxic to aquatic organisms. After sewage neutralisation the acidity is no longer relevant, while the surfactants are, together with most of the other organic components, largely degraded during the usual dwelling time of sewage in treatment plants. Remnants eventually released into natural waters are immediately subject to further degradation processes and will soon disappear from the environment.

Non-readily biodegradable components consist practically exclusively of fragrances (etheric oils), which according to their function in nature are only slowly biodegraded.

The release of phosphates into the environment depends on the equipment of the particular sewage treatment plant. Possible eutrophication effects should be considered in relation to the total phosphorus load of the sewage.
